Risk Factors/Causes

- Atherosclerosis
- Emboli
 - Cardiac sources: valves or myxoma
- Coagulopathies
 - Sickle cell
 - Oral contraceptives
 - pregnancy
 - homocystinuria
 - platelet abnormalities
 - clotting factor abnormalities
 - Collagen vascular diseases
- Ocular abnormalities
 - Arterial loops
 - optic disc drusen
- Migraine
- Hypotension
- Trauma
- Age
 - 60 + years old
- Gender
 - more men than women are affected.
- 1-2 % are bilateral
