

Cloudy Cornea in Neonates

Possible Causes

- Trauma
 - Forceps
 - Chemical injury
 - Needle perforation with amnioscentesis
- Infections (corneal ulceration possible)
 - Herpes Simplex
 - Rubella
 - Nisseria gonorrhoeae
- Glaucoma (increased IOP)
- Metabolic
 - Mucopolysaccharidoses-MPS-IH (Hurlers)
 - Mucolipodoses-type IV
 - Glycogen Storage Disease type I (Von Gierke),
 - Cystinosis
 - Tyrosinemia (type II)
- Dysgenesis
 - Peters anomaly
 - Dermoid (choristoma)
 - Sclerocornea
 - [Posterior keratoconus](#)
- Corneal dystrophy
 - PPMD
 - CHED
 - CHSD
- Skin disease
 - ichthyosis
 - dayskeratoses
- Keratomalacia (Vitamin A deficiency)
