

Neurofibromatosis type I

Diagnostic Criteria

Two or More of the following

- 6 or more **café-au-lait spots**
 - >5 mm in greatest diameter prepubertal children
 - >15 mm in greatest diameter in postpubertal individuals
- Axillary or inguinal **freckling**
- 2 or more cutaneous **neurofibromas**
- 1 plexiform neurofibroma
- 2 or more **Lisch nodules**
 - [Lisch nodules in NF-1](#). Lubs et al. NEJM 1991
- **Optic nerve glioma**
- A characteristic **bony lesion**
 - sphenoid wing hypoplasia/dysplasia
 - thinning of long bone cortex with or without pseudarthrosis (poor ossification or non-union of bone creating a “false joint”)
- First-degree relative with NF1

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
