

# Oculo-Digital Sign

AKA: Oculo-digital phenomenon, [Franceschetti-Leber Phenomenon](#)

- Repeated pressure applied to the eye by a child with blindness or low vision.
- Presumably this pressure creates a [phosphene](#) that is interesting to the child.
- It is not specific for one particular ocular disease
- It was first mentioned by Theodor Leber in 1877 but identified as the oculo-digital phenomenon by Franceschetti in 1937

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
