Sensorineural Hearing Loss

- Ocular screening is recommended due to the frequent co-incidence of ocular disease
- Eye exam when first diagnosed and follow up as required.

Ocular/Visual Screening Recommendations

- Complete Eye Exam
- Additional specialized testing based on findings
